General traffic regulations

The German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) apply throughout the exhibition center.

The speed limit on the grounds is 30 km per hour.

Regardless of the vehicle type, people drive onto the grounds at their own risk. Access is granted only if a valid access or parking permit can be shown.

Construction vehicles and containers may not be parked or set down on the exhibition grounds during the trade fair.

A limited number of parking spaces for trucks, trailers and containers is available at the exhibition center and can be rented with form T. 24 through our Koelnmesse Service Portal (koelnmesse-service-portal@koelnmesse.de) for a fee of **€ 250, 00 (plus 19% VAT)**.

P22 will be available for parking trucks for the duration of the fair.

Parking fee €100, 00 has to be paid there upon arrival. There are no reservations necessary!

Construction and dismantling: General regulations

During the construction and dismantling periods, trucks are directed by a special guidance system close to the trade fair grounds.



The following regulations apply during IMB 2009 for vehicles over 3.5 tons:

1. Trucks over 3.5 tons will be directed to P22 from April 14th, 2009.

At P22, vehicles will be registered and access permission will be granted for entering the trade fair grounds.

Access will not be granted to the trade fair grounds unless:

- The exact delivery location (hall, stand number, service door) has been assigned
- The required logistics services have been provided by the contract transport agency
- The required areas for loading and unloading are available at the halls
- The customs handling can be completed

Our traffic staff at P22 will direct trucks to the grounds.

2. When the dismantling period begins (on the last day of the trade fair), all arriving vehicles will be directed to P22 by means of signposting and with police assistance.

Vehicles may not access the trade fair grounds until 7:00 p.m. on April 24th, 2009.

Special regulations apply to vehicles weighing less than 3.5 tons (see access regulations on the last day of the trade fair).

Please note:

Vehicles will not be granted access to the trade fair grounds unless they first go to P22!

Access regulations

Last day of the fair/dismantling: April 24th, 2009

Arriving vehicles will be directed to P22 by means of signposting and with police assistance.

Vehicles used for dismantling will not be granted access to the grounds until 7:00 p.m. on the last day of the trade fair.

On the last day of the trade fair, owners/users of vehicles weighing up to 3.5 tons can drive onto the grounds from **5:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.** with separate access permission. The relevant access permission can be obtained in a limited number for a deposit of € 100, 00 (in cash).

Opening hours of the ticket counter

April 19th and 20th, 2009: 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Ticket counter is located at the Service-Center North)

April 24th, 2009: 1:00 p. m. to 4:00 p.m. (Security Center North and P 22)

The deposit will be returned upon handing over of the original deposit receipt at the **gate A** if the vehicle leaves by the exit deadline (**6:45p.m.**).
